#### \*In the Works\*

- \*Stowe Bridges BR#48 & BR#51 CCS work continues w/ VTrans & the Town of Stowe on Nebraska Valley Rd for the full replacement of the two bridges overlooking Miller Brook. Traffic will be maintained on a one-lane alternating temporary bridge with a signal. The target completion for both structures is Fall of 2025.
- \*Rockingham, VT Bridge BR#38 CCS continues to work on the full bridge replacement on US-5 in Rockingham crossing the Green Mountain Railroad. This construction required a road closure with a detour for work to progress. CCS is making strides to complete this project by Fall 2025.
- \*Wolcott, VT Bridge #6 on School St over the Lamoille River. The original bridge was built in 1928. Replacement of the existing Parker Pony Truss & bridge will continue into 2026.
- \*Town of Strafford, VT The bridge replacement on Freeman Road is almost complete
- \*Town of Vershire, VT CCS has completed the replacement of the Mero Road Bridge.

### \*On The Smaller Side - But Just As Important\*

\*Crane Rentals – CCS has had a busy summer working with a variety of customers on smaller crane jobs. Our crews have worked to set in place many items like; precast culverts, trusses, granite blocks, granite stairways & walls, water towers, digesters, precast concrete abutments, bridge beams, unload heavy equipment as well as a multitude of other odd jobs.

#### \* Jobs On the Horizon \*

\*Hardwick Pedestrian Wall & Bridge – CCS is teaming up with the Town of Hardwick to rebuild the retaining wall & pedestrian bridge that crosses over the Lamoille River. Project to start in Spring 2026.
